FACILITY IN FREEPORT, PENNSYLVANIA**

Federal Business unit will build advanced fiber optic
intrusion detection and surveillance systems

Freeport, PA - August 12, 2005 - Sabeus Inc., a leading independent developer of fiber optic systems for acoustic sensing, intrusion detection and surveillance applications today announced the grand opening of its newest production & R&D facility in Freeport, Pennsylvania at a ribbon-cutting ceremony attended by guest of honor Congressman John P. Murtha. Sabeus' Federal Systems division will be based in the new 15,000 square foot facility located in the Northpointe Technology Center, 27 miles north of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

"This day is a tribute to the progress we've made in creating and building an electro-optics industry in Western Pennsylvania," said Murtha, who was instrumental in establishing the Electro Optics Center.
